The Wiltshire Junior Open is a qualifying event for the London Junior Chess Championships. Qualification for the London Junior Chess Championships, in the U8, U10, and U12 sections, is by ECF Grade or by achieving a qualifying score at a qualifying event.

Players qualify for entry in all sections dependent on their age on 31st August 2018.

U14 and U18 sections will be amalgamated should there be insufficient entries to run either separately.

Tournament Format

The event will be organised as a **6 round Rapid Play Swiss** Tournament. This is not a knockout tournament. Clocks will be used in all sections – time control: **30 min.**, incremental timing will not be used. Assistance will be given to any player who has not previously used a chess clock

Venue

Wiltshire Junior Chess is pleased to accept the hospitality of the Swindon Hindu Temple Trust in hosting this event. The temple and cultural centre is a place of worship and we must ask all attending to respect the devotional nature of the venue and Hindu customs; footwear must not be worn upstairs in the temple prayer area, a place exists for the removal and storage of shoes, shoes may be worn on the ground floor. You are welcome to bring food to eat at the event however, meat, eggs and food containing meat or eggs should be avoided at the venue. Hot and cold drinks, snacks and refreshments will be available on the day. Whilst we have these small restrictions, we are sure you will find the venue educational and engaging. Grading

All games will be submitted for Rapid Play grading. It is a condition of entry that you consent to the necessary personal data being submitted to the ECF for grading. ECF Silver/Gold/Platinum Members (but not Bronze members) may claim a discount equal to the ECF Junior 'Pay-To-Play' fee. **ECF Silver membership is free for the first year**, details may be found on the ECF website. Prizes

U8, U10, U12	Trophies for: Winner, Runner-up, 1 st and 2 nd placed Wiltshire players, Medals for: 3 rd place, 1 st and 2 nd placed Wiltshire novices (a player who has not previously played in a Wiltshire tournament), controller's prize. In the event of a tie, trophies will be awarded according to each players' sum of progressive scores.
U14, U18	Cash Prizes for winner and runner-up dependent on entry. In the event of a tie, winner and runner-up cash prizes will be shared equally.

Disputes

In the event of any dispute that cannot be settled by the section controller the controller will request adjudication by the Chief Arbiter. The decision of the Chief Arbiter will be final.

Disclaimer

Wiltshire Junior Chess will only provide adult supervision in the chess playing area and while games are in progress. While games are in progress only the players, controllers and arbiter are allowed to remain in the chess playing area. All children must be accompanied during the day by their parent(s), guardian, or a nominated responsible adult who will be responsible for their children during the tournament. The organisers and helpers will not act *in loco parentis* and are not able to take responsibility for any child's actions, or for the actions of anyone that may affect your child.
