### Getting there

### Coming by Underground

The venue is a four minute walk from Northwick Park station on the Metropolitan Line. There is a footpath from the station under the railway line, with access to the site nearby.

The University of Westminster is a ten minute walk from Harrow-on-the-Hill station.

#### Coming by rail

Kenton station is six minutes away. Some main line trains to Euston stop at either Watford Junction or Harrow and Wealdstone which connect with Kenton station.
